For information Domestic related offences are those offences on Crime File where the Domestic Incident Description attribute equals 'Yes'. In respect of solved offences on Crime File the same criteria applies, while in respect of the Crime Recording System it is those offences where the Domestic 'flag' is set at 'Yes'. This criteria is the same as that used for Chief Officer monthly MAP meetings.

DA - Familial Relationship* is where the Domestic Incident Description attribute equals Yes on Crime File (CRS Domestic flag = Yes) and where the relationship between the Victim and Suspect (s) is familial. Please note that there is no specific marker denoting a familial relationship on the Crime System - however a judgement can be made based on the attribute' victim suspect relation description'. To clarify a familial relationship is where the victim suspect relation description attribute clearly records a family connection. The relationship of the suspect to the victim will therefore be a family one: ie:-that of brother, step brother, brother in law, cousin, husband/ex husband, father, step -father, father - in - law, Grandparent, son, Uncle, wife or ex wife (etc).
