1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,053 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to Epping Forest District Council, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex. This would secure or lead to securing a reduction in crime and disorder.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of the NIF grant to purchase 5 CCTV Cameras

- 3.1 Loaned CCTV cameras will be used to gather evidence in support of allegations of Anti-Social Behaviour, deterring bogus callers, and to reassure potential victims.
