1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £5,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the PCC Community Safety Fund to Crimestoppers, whose activities contribute to the priorities set out in the Essex Police and Crime Plan.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of £5,000 from the PCC's CSF for the Crimestoppers Eastern region manager's post for 2014-15.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 Funding for the Regional Manager post allows Essex Police to have a 24/7 point of contact with the national charity and for them to receive dedicated support to help address their policing priorities and fill their intelligence gaps
- 3.2 Better quality intelligence for Essex Police leading to an improvement in their detection rate which means fewer future victims of crime

3.2 More activity from the local volunteer committee who are able to add value and enable better quality information to be generated due to improved collaboration with Essex Police on priorities and intelligence gaps

4. Background and proposal

4.1 This funding is a contribution towards the cost of the Crimestoppers Eastern region's manager post.

4.2 The regional manager took-up post part-funded by the six Eastern Region Forces in early May 2010, matching the Charity's own contribution annually for a three year period. To ensure our national aims are achieved locally, Crimestoppers is aiming for continued support of Ann Scott. The required annual contribution from Essex PCC is £5,000.

5. Police and Crime Plan

5.1. This proposal supports the PCC's vision and delivery of the following key areas of focus:

- Improving crime prevention
- Supporting victims of crime



