1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,426 from the PCC's Victims Fund to Safer Places, in support of the priorities within the Police and Crime Plan

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of a grant from the PCC's Victims Fund to Safer Places to provide funding for the uplift of the CRU IDVA lead.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The uplift of the IDVA CRU lead will strengthen the arrangements in the CRU and bring the different VCS organisations who deliver IDVA services together.
- 3.2 It is a small investment which should support collaboration within the CRU and between VCS partners.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 The individual (IDVA CRU lead) who will be acting-up is funded externally by Safer Places. The decision to have an IDVA worker in the CRU act-up was taken in consultation with a number of VCS organisations operating in this

area. These proposed arrangements will help to develop the future IDVA / JDATT model.
