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1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £23,487 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Force Lost and Found monies to Essex Community Foundation (ECF).

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of the grant to the Essex Community Foundation Police Property Act Fund.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 Funding is allocated to the Essex Community Foundation Police Property Act Fund. The fund aims to support charitable activities across Essex, Southend and Thurrock.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1. In line with the 1997 Police Property Act, the Essex Police Authority agreed to use the surplus from lost and found items & unclaimed monies to leave a legacy for their work and established the Police Property Act Fund with the Essex Community Foundation. The PCC has made the decision to continue this policy of donating lost and found monies to the Police Property Act Fund.

5. Police and Crime Plan

5.1. This proposal supports the PCC's vision and delivery of the following key areas of focus:

7. Financial Implications

7.1 The PCC would fund a £23,487 contribution to Essex Community Foundation. The sum total of £23,487 is for the sale of property in the possession of the Police to which the Police Property Act applies, and is made up of £10,690 brought forward from 2012-13 and £12,797 from 2013-14.

8.1 The management of the fund held by ECF on behalf of the PCC is subject to the existing funding agreement between the PCC & ECF.
