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**1. Purpose of report**

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £300 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the PCC Community Safety Fund to Basildon Borough Council.

**2. Recommendations**

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of £300 from the PCC's CSF to contribute to venue costs for the Essex Community Trigger Workshop taking place on 2 July 2014.

**3. Benefits of Proposal**

- 3.1 The aim of the session is to give agencies, who are being asked to identify single points of contact for purposes of the review panel, the opportunity to try out the working models using case studies, identify whether triggers have been met, what future actions might be taken etc.

#### **4. Background and proposal**

- 4.1 It is anticipated that the Community Trigger legislation will be enacted in autumn 2014 so this is very timely. It will also give agencies the opportunity to embed the processes and systems into their organisations beforehand.
- 4.2 Safer Essex has made £850 of funding available for the conference and has requested partial funding for the event from the PCC.
