# 1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 To seek approval for the carry forward of funds into 2014/15 for the Sexual Offences Investigation Temporary Team (SOIT), Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) replacement plan and Covert Operation.

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# 4.0 Background and Proposal

### 4.1 SOIT temporary team

Risk 79 on the Corporate Risk Register is amber and relates to the increasing demand for investigations into Serious Sexual Offences and the limited capacity within the present team. The utilisation of 12 civilian investigators (agency staff) on a temporary basis until Evolve's evaluation is complete, would seek to reduce the risk and meet demand.

### 4.2 UPS replacement plan

The age of both the switch gear, which operates the UPS system under emergency conditions, and the power panels in FCR electric room are of significant concern and represent a single point of failure for the FCR in not having the ability to provide a command and control service.

### 4.3 Covert operation

Following discussions that took place at the PCC Finance Governance
Meeting between the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Chief
Constable, support is sought to allocate a carry forward to be used against a
covert operation.
