**1. Purpose of report**

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £19,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Victims Capacity Building Fund to Catch22, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

**2. Recommendations**

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of the Victims Capacity Building Fund grant to deliver a young victims of crime research project to inform future commissioning.

**3. Benefits of Proposal**

- 3.1 The proposal is to inform our future commissioning around young victims by undertaking a research project to;
- Understand the needs and experiences of young people experiencing victimisation
  - Understand the extent and effectiveness of current practice with young people experiencing victimisation in Essex, including how services engage with this target group
  - Complete a gap and needs analysis to inform the development of service provision to meet the needs of the target group
  - Use this understanding to inform the way in which programmes can work with young people experiencing victimisation


