1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £250 from the PCC's Victims Fund to NHS England, Essex Area Team, in support of the priorities within the Police and Crime Plan.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of a grant from the PCC's Victims Fund to NHS England, Essex Area Team for replacement clothing to be provided for victims attending the SARC.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 This funding will be used to purchase replacement clothing for victims of sexual assault attending the SARC when their clothing is required to be retained for forensic examination or as evidence.
- 3.2 OPCC have arranged to contribute 50% of the anticipated spend with NHS England, Essex Area Team covering the remaining 50%.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1 The current contract for the SARC includes no provision for replacement clothing. This allocation will provide replacement clothing for victims between now and April 2015 when a new contract will take effect which places the responsibility for these costs with the supplier.


