## 1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £8,476 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the NIF to Stambridge Parish Council, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

#### 2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the NIF grant to purchase fishing equipment and deliver a fishing diversionary intervention programme with young people in Rochford.

#### 3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 Establishment of a youth fishing club as a diversionary project for local young people (9-17). The club will teach young people additional skills, and divert them away from risky behaviours.
- 3.2 The funding includes the purchase of equipment which will provide a resource that can be used over a long period of time, giving the project sustainability. A number of local volunteer coaches have already been engaged.

#### 4. Background and proposal

- 4.1 This equipment application is supported by a proposal in the standard format.
- 4.2 We have included a stipulation in the funding agreement that this equipment will remain the property of the OPCC but will be made available to the group free of charge.

4.3 The proposal benefits from £1,000 match-funding from the Parish Council.
