## 1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £47,525 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2015-16 Community Safety Fund to Crimestoppers, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

#### 2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of a Community Safety Fund grant to Crimestoppers to contribute towards the annual costs of their national anonymous crime reporting service and towards the costs of the Eastern region manager.

### 3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The funding will be used to allow Crimestoppers to continue to offer their national anonymous crime reporting service.
- 3.2. In the last year Crimestoppers received 1,319 reports that led to 317 arrests and positive crime outcomes in Essex, with £291,520 worth of money and drugs recovered.

#### 4. Background and proposal

- 4.1 This funding represents an annual contribution to Crimestoppers for the costs of their Bureau (£42,525) and regional manager post (£5,000).
