1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £8,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the CSDF to Open Door, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of the CSDF grant to Open Door to deliver a group work programme for young people at risk of risky behaviours

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The project will involve a 10-week structured programme for 70 young people in Thurrock. Referrals into the programme will come via youth offending, housing, troubled families, substance misuse services and missing people
- 3.2 The project will aim to reduce risk-taking behaviour amongst young people by encouraging participation in positive activities and working towards raising self-esteem and confidence

4. Background and proposal

- 4.2 The project benefits from £9,750 match-funding from Thurrock CSP and the troubled families project


