1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for an allocation of £19,536 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the CSDF to The Wilderness Foundation whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the CSDF grant to The Wilderness Foundation to deliver the Turnaround project for 20 young people across Essex.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The Turnaround project is a personal development program which uses nature as a catalyst for young people to make positive changes to their behaviour, choices and lives.
- 3.2 The project aims to deliver the following:
 - Decrease offending and anti-social behaviour
 - Remedy the long-term impact of hidden harm and life trauma
 - Increase young people's self-esteem and self-confidence
 - Improve young people's social, communications, and problem-solving skills
 - Help young people to learn to be accountable to themselves and others
 - Train young people to practice anger and mood management and selfcontrol
 - Guide young people to build trust in others whilst practicing teamwork skills
