1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,268,686 in the form of crime and disorder reduction grants from the 2016-17 Community Safety Fund to statutory organisations as detailed in section 3 below, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

- 2.1. Approve funding of £1,268,686 to the statutory organisations as detailed below.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. These grants represent core funding for Community Safety Partnerships, Youth Offending Teams and Drug and Alcohol Teams and will allow those organisations to undertake local community safety interventions and projects that impact on the areas of focus within the Police & Crime Plan.
