1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for an allocation of £5,250 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the CSDF to Castle Point Association of Voluntary Services whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of the CSDF grant to Castle Point Association of Voluntary Services to deliver the Keep Scheme in the Castlepoint and Rochford areas.

3. Benefits of Proposal

The project:

- offers vulnerable people safe access to telephone facilities in a variety of venues - shops, business premises, libraries, supermarkets - should they become distressed, anxious, unwell or in trouble in the town centre
- supports and promote existing resources (through its information pack and links to Community Safety Partnerships across Essex) such as the PCC Elder Abuse Helpline, the Hate Incident Reporting Centre and Hate Crime Ambassador network (some HIRCs are Keep Safe premises too), the Stop Hate UK Learning Disability Hate Crime Helpline, Ask Sal (Essex Safeguarding Adults Board) etc.
- will also deliver a countywide Keep Safe website which will significantly increase the reach and potential of the scheme to become a county model of safety awareness for vulnerable people.
