1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £47,525 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2016-17 Community Safety Fund to Crimestoppers, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of a Community Safety Fund grant to Crimestoppers to contribute towards the annual costs of their national anonymous crime reporting service and towards the costs of the Eastern region manager.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1. This funding allows Crimestoppers to continue to offer their national anonymous crime reporting telephone service. This service provides actionable intelligence to Essex Police from anonymous sources, giving those wishing not to disclose their identity the opportunity to provide valuable information to the Police.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 This funding represents an annual contribution to Crimestoppers for the costs of their Bureau (£42,525) and the regional manager post (£5,000).

- 5.1. This proposal supports the PCC's vision and delivery of the following key areas of focus:
 - Improving crime prevention
 - Ensuring local solutions meet local problems
 - Increasing efficiency in policing through collaborative working and innovation
