1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £50,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Community Safety Fund to Essex Community Foundation, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of £50,000 from the PCC's 2015-16 Community Safety Fund to invest in the Essex Community Resilience endowment Fund that will provide sustainable funding to promote resilient communities within Essex.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The funding will be used to invest in local community projects and activities to help keep communities strong and safe. This will help to contribute to community safety outcomes within the Police and Crime Plan.
- 3.2. The primary purpose of the fund is to support the voluntary and community sector to develop the ability of communities, family and individuals to help themselves and each other.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1 Along with other public sector partners, the PCC has committed to make ongoing contributions to the Community Resilience Fund (CRF). The CRF is an endowed fund and will generate an annual source of sustainable funding that will be invested directly into the local voluntary and community sector for

the purpose of strengthening communities. The fund will be held and administered by Essex Community Foundation (ECF).

4.2 This contribution is in addition to a £75k allocation made in 2014-15.

5. Police and Crime Plan

5.1. This proposal supports the PCC's vision and delivery of the following key areas of focus:

- Improving crime prevention
- Ensuring local solutions meet local problems
- Increasing efficiency in policing through collaborative working and innovation
