1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £3,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Community Safety Fund (CSF) to Essex Police, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of the Community Safety Fund (CSF) to Essex Police to fund a campaign that encourages perpetrators of domestic abuse to reflect on, and subsequently seek support to, change their behaviour.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The campaign aims to increase recognition of abusive behaviour and encourage victims and perpetrators to seek support to break the cycle of abuse.
- 3.2. This is the third phase of the partnership's #Togetherwecan domestic abuse awareness raising campaign and is supported by the Essex partnership domestic abuse strategy.
