1. Purpose of report

1.1 To seek approval for the allocation of £27,000 from the Police and Crime Commissioner's Transformation Reserve to fund work related to the Fire Collaboration.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To approve funding of £20,000 to The Consultation Institute who will provide advice and quality assurance throughout the consultation process.
- 2.2 To approve funding of £2,000 to RP2 who will provide promotion (social media seeding) of the consultation animation for the public consultation of the Local Business Case, Fire and Police governance.
- 2.3 To approve funding of £5,000 to Deadline Communications who will provide animation for the public consultation of the Local Business Case, Fire and Police governance.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 The Consultation Institute will provide advice and assurance from an independent quality assurance and advice provider.
- 3.2 This service provided will assess the public consultation approach and materials for the fire and police local governance local business case. Advice from a consultation expert is given throughout the time of the consultation, an assessor will check through all the materials and a mark will be awarded at the end of the consultation
- 3.3 The seeding will aim to achieve 21,500 views
- 3.4 We will be able to demonstrate that we have taken reasonable action to engage with the public and to make it accessible.
- 3.5 The animation will enable the PCC to engage with the county in a digital and easy to access format.
- 3.6 The animation will set the scene for the consultation and bring all printed materials to life.

4. Background and proposal

4.1 Due to pending change in legislation the PCC is able to build a local case for the change in governance of the Police and Fire and Rescue Service. This case has been developed and consists of three possible options. We need to consult with the public on these options and include the feedback in the final business case. The consultation will run for 12 weeks from February 16th – 10th May. To ensure we plan and conduct appropriate engagement and produce clear consultation materials, we require advice and quality assurance. The Consultation Institute has provided a good service to the Fire 2020 programme and too many other public consultations.

5. Police and Crime Plan

5.1 Supports the priorities in the Police and Crime Plan – in particular, the work in relation to closer collaboration with the Fire Service.
