**1. Purpose of report**

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £600 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2016-17 Community Safety Fund to the Essex Safeguarding Board.

**2. Recommendations**

- 2.1. Approve payment of the grant to the Essex Safeguarding Board to deliver a development day for all 3 safeguarding boards to improve their understanding of the statutory responsibilities of safeguarding boards.

**3. Benefits of Proposal**

- 3.1. The project aims to;
- improve the three safeguarding board members' knowledge and understanding of law related to adult safeguarding boards
  - improve the knowledge of the three safeguarding board members' knowledge of their legal responsibilities as board members
  - provide space for board members to consider future opportunities for collaboration.

**4. Background and proposal**


- 4.1. This proposal is to provide an opportunity for the Safeguarding Boards in Southend, Essex and Thurrock to join together collaboratively to develop their understanding and knowledge of the statutory responsibilities of both the Boards and their members.

- 4.2. The session will be led by Michael Mandlestam, a national expert in adult safeguarding and social care law.
- 4.3. This will be the first time the three Safeguarding Adults Boards (Essex, Southend & Thurrock) have joined together in this way and will provide space for consideration of future opportunities to collaborate.
- 4.4. The OPCC has been invited to send a representative to this event
