To seek approval for the allocation of £686 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2016-17 Community Safety Fund (CSF) to SGO services.

- 3. Benefits of Proposal**  
SGO services, in partnership with the Institute for Community Safety developed the Essex Violence and Vulnerability Framework which will be presented to Safer Essex and the Police and Crime Commissioner in separate meetings on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017. This funding is for travel, accommodation, and day-rate for Paul Cullen (SGO services) to deliver these presentations.

Over the last 6 months ICS have consulted with local stakeholders to develop a framework to address violence and vulnerability across Essex. This payment will secure SGO services to present the draft framework to the PCC and Safer Essex
