1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £75,627 from the Essex Police Lost and Found monies account to the Essex Community Foundation.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 Approve the allocation of £75,627 to the Essex Community Foundation (Police Property Act endowed Fund).

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 This funding will be allocated to the Essex Community Foundation's Police Property Act (PPA) Fund. The PPA fund makes annual grants to support local community or voluntary organisations across Essex, Southend and Thurrock for activity that will promote community safety and support the delivery of the objectives within the Police & Crime Plan.

ECF are responsible for the management and administration of the PPA and present the PCC with a shortlist of recommended projects each financial year for PCC approval.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1 Previously the Essex Police Authority agreed to use the surplus from lost and found items and unclaimed monies to leave a legacy for their work and established the Police Property Act Fund with the Essex Community Foundation. The OPCC has continued with this policy. This allocation reflects monies collected between 2013 and 2016.

7. Financial Implications

- 7.1 The OPCC will fund a £75,627 contribution to Essex Community Foundation. The sum of £75,627 is to be funded from the lost and found monies collected by Essex Police between 2013 and 2016. The fund has accumulated since 2013/14 and the funds have been carried forward until the 2016/17 year end.
