1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,300 to support Essex Police's "Secure. Protect. Prevent." campaign.

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve the allocation of £1,300 to Essex Police as a contribution towards the costs of the campaign to encourage people to consider whether their home is as safe as it can be.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1. Communications activity over a two week period starting on Monday October, 23 will deliver community safety messages and act as a call to arms around dwelling burglary, millennium burglary and home security.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1. The objectives of the campaign are;
 - To lower the risk of dwelling and millennium burglary by getting members of the public to **take action**, via an online questionnaire, on securing their home
 - To **raise awareness** of distraction burglary to family members of the high risk group 60+
 - Get 21% of questionnaires from the high risk area of Basildon

- To inform and raise awareness of home security for students
- 4.2. Dwelling burglary increases in the winter months by 12.8% compared to the summer months. Both dwelling burglary (6.8%) and millennium burglary (8%) increased from the previous year. The Crime Prevention Tactical Advisors' research shows that offenders offend where they are comfortable, therefore the campaign is going to focus on informing residents about the importance of keeping their homes secure and how they can do this.

- 5.1. This proposal supports the PCC's priority to provide more local, visible and accessible policing and by protecting vulnerable people from harm.
