**1. Purpose of report**

To seek approval for the allocation of £8,975 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Community Safety Development Fund to Essex Community Foundation.

**2. Recommendations**

Approve the allocation of the Community Safety Development Fund to Essex Community Foundation who will distribute the funds to approved local organisations (identified in section 3) to deliver a variety of community safety projects that will support the objectives of the Police and Crime Plan.

Barnados CAPI	£2,975	Protecting children and vulnerable people	CAPI provides specialist courses for girls in 4 secondary schools across Southend and Thurrock who are at risk of/already engaging, offending behaviour/hidden harms i.e. drugs, alcohol, gangs and CSE. The project also includes family support and training for professionals.
London Bus Theatre Company	£2,500	Protecting children and vulnerable people	The theatre company provide free drama workshops for year 6 pupils in the most deprived wards of Southend and Canvey via their established project entitles "Kick it Binge Drinking and Antisocial Behaviour" addressing the need to address alcohol abuse and resultant ASB on some local estates in areas of deprivation.

The Police Property Act Fund is a fund that is managed by Essex Community Foundation (ECF). ECF invited applications from local organisations to bid for a share of the £11,000 available within the fund. Applications had to support the local community and police and crime plan. ECF on behalf of the OPFCC thoroughly review the applications and provide a decision on successful applicants.

During the most recent funding round ECF received strong funding applications from a number of organisations that due to the limited funding they were unable to award too.

These applications were shared with the OPFCC recognised their strength in supporting the Police and Crime Plan. Therefore the OPFCC would like to provide some additional funding of £8,975 to ECF to distribute to the applicants.
