1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £94 to provide lunch to partners attending a workshop which aims to improve out of court disposal outcomes.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of £94 to provide lunch at the above event. The event will include representatives from Essex Police, PFCC, Youth Offending Teams, Community Safety Partnerships, CRC, and Local Authorities.

- 3.2. By encouraging partners to attend the workshop, we will be better able to collaborate on outcomes, leading to better results and shared resource.

- 4.1 Out of Court (Police) disposals in Essex are perhaps not used as effectively as they could be.
- 4.2 While the use of these disposals must necessarily increase, due to changes in legislation, it is not clear that there is a good join up between how the police are using these disposals and the treatment and support options that are available to vulnerable people that would make these disposals more effective.
- 4.3 This workshop aims to bring together key agencies to begin the process of making the use of these disposals more effective in Essex.
