1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £390 in the form of a discretionary grant from the PFCC's 2018-19 Community Safety Fund to Essex County Fire and Rescue Service

2.1. Approve the allocation of a grant to Essex County Fire and Rescue Service for catering and refreshments for the Essex Compact Annual General Meeting.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1. The Essex COMPACT AGM will provide a forum and opportunity for statutory and voluntary partners to consider opportunities for improved partnership working between sectors which ultimately facilitate positive outcomes for Essex residents.

4. Background and proposal

4.1. The Essex Compact is a voluntary agreement which aims to underpin and support better joint working between statutory agencies, such as the PFCC and Essex Police, and the voluntary and community sector in working together fairly and productively to improve the well-being of people living and working in Essex. It sets out principles and standards for a good, open, fair relationship between statutory and voluntary agencies.

- 4.2. The Compact benefits from match funding and in-kind contributions from Essex County Fire & Rescue Service and Essex County Council.
- 4.3. The PFCC will provide funding to make refreshments and catering available to support the event which will be held at ECF&RS HQ on 10th May 2018.
