1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of a further £11,000 from the 2018-19 Community Safety Fund to Essex Community Foundation.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of an additional £11,000 from the PFCC's 2018-19 CSF to Essex Community Foundation for the expansion of the #IWILL project, previously called the Youth Social Action Fund.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The #iwill campaign is a national campaign that promotes social action among 10-20 year-olds. This includes activities such as campaigning, fundraising and volunteering, all of which create a double-benefit – to communities and young people themselves.
- 3.2. The Fund will allocate small grants of between £1,000 and £5,000 for projects that meet the quality principles for great social action;
- Reflective
 - Challenging
 - Youth-led
 - Socially impactful
 - Progressive
 - Embedded
- 3.3. The project in Essex has been administered and managed since April 2017 by Essex Community Foundation who also provide match-funding for the PFCC's investment. This additional grant will enable the project to be rolled out across

the whole of Essex in year 2 of the project. The PFCC's total contribution over 2 years will be £99k.

4. Background and proposal

4.1. This decision relates to original decision sheet PCC/ 0106/16.

4.2. A number of changes have been made to the fund since the original decision, namely;

- The name of the Fund and the name that will be used to promote the fund will change in year 2 from 'Youth Social Action' to '#IWILL'
- The geographic area covered by the #IWILL campaign will extend from West Essex to the whole of Essex
- The available Community Foundation funding for year 2 has increased by £10,000 to £50,000. The PFCC will allocate a further £11,000 (£55,000 in total in year 2).

4.3. The PFCC's contribution is match-funded 1:1 by the Community Foundation. Essex Community Foundation levy a 10% management fee for this project.

5. Police and Crime Plan

5.1. This project will support the PFCC's priority to protect vulnerable people from harm and will support the overarching ambition to promote partnership working.
