## 1. Purpose of report

To seek approval for the allocation of £5,000 from the 2018-19 Community Safety Fund to Essex County Fire & Rescue.

#### 2. Recommendations

Approve the allocation of £5,000 from the PFCC's 2018-19 CSF to Essex County Fire & Rescue to purchase Personal Protective Equipment for their RTC extrication team to support their national competition programme.

#### 3. Benefits of Proposal

The benefit of this proposal is ensuring members of the RTC Extrication Team are appropriately protected this would support their training in the event that they are required to undertake a live exercise.

The team's competition programme is actively promoted by Essex County Fire & Rescue Service which also contributes to an increasing awareness of the impact and consequences of drink, drug and/or dangerous driving.

#### 4. Background and proposal

The RTC extrication team travel around the country representing Essex Fire Service at competitions against other fire services, but on top of that also deliver a lot of demonstrations locally to raise the awareness around RTC's.

The proposal is to contribute £5000 to the purchasing of personal protective equipment. The RTC extrication team made up of 13 people require the personal protection equipment for future competitions and awareness raising activity in order to continue to complete these safely.

#### 5. Police and Crime Plan

This project will support the PFCC's priority contributing to priority 7 Improve safety on our roads in ensuring fewer people are killed or seriously injured on the roads.
