1. Purpose of report

To formally record agreement of a change to the draft Accounts for 2017-18. This to the reverse an entry to reduce earmarked reserves by £1.2m to fund additional capital financing charges.

2. Recommendations

- a. That an entry in the draft accounts for 2017-18 to release £1.2m from earmarked reserves to fund additional capital financing charges be reversed.
- b. A revised set of Accounts then be prepared and agreed with our external auditors for publication by 31st July 2018.

3. Benefits and Costs of Proposal

The Fire and Rescue Service is in the process of formulating an initial reserves strategy for publication. In addition, the strategic position on reserves will become much clearer once we have completed The Fire and Rescue Plan and financial projections 2020 to 2024.

Any decisions on the use of reserves are better dealt with as part of our medium term planning 2020 to 2024 when we will be better informed on future reserves strategy.

4. Background and proposal

The original proposal to release £1.2m from earmarked reserves to fund additional contributions to capital financing was made last year, since that time the net expenditure outturn for 2017-18 was better than forecast. In addition, we are currently reviewing our reserves strategy and will have a much clearer view on reserves once we have completed the Fire and Rescue Plan and financial projections 2020-2024.

For these reasons the release of £1.2m from reserves has been subject to further consideration resulting in a recommendation to reverse the treatment in the draft Accounts and reinstate earmarked reserves of £1.2m.

This recommendation will ensure that any decision on reserves is properly aligned to the Fire and Rescue plan 2020 to 2024 and also our published reserves strategy.
