1. Purpose of report

To seek approval for an allocation of £5,800 in the form of crime and disorder reduction grants from the Community Safety Development Fund to Southend United Community and Educational Trust.

2. Recommendations

Approve the allocation of the CSDF grants to Southend United Community and Educational Trust to deliver a community safety project that will support the objectives of the Police and Crime Plan to reverse the trend in serious violence and to protect children and vulnerable people from harm.

3. Benefits of Proposal

The project aims are;

- For young people to demonstrate a feeling of control of their lives and their future
- Contribute towards reducing the number of people killed/seriously injured across Essex as a result of using weapons

4. Background and proposal

The evaluation panel is made up of a number of local independent stakeholders using the evaluation mechanism set out in the Fund's published criteria.

Southend United Community and Educational Trust are planning a short high impact project that will directly educate over 900 children/young people against knife crime and reach many more through an anti-knife campaign and promotion of knife amnesty.

The panel was held on 16th July 2018 and approved a contribution to the Southend United Community and Educational Trust project. The panel awarded a contribution and not the full amount requested. This was due to elements of the application that overlapped with existing work that Essex Fire and Rescue were delivering in regards to knife awareness in schools. It was the recommendation of the panel that Southend United community and Educational Trust work with Essex Fire and Rescue in delivering this activity.

The projects mentioned in section 2 support the following priorities in the Police and Crime Plan

- Protecting children and vulnerable people from harm
- Tackle gangs and organised crime
