- 1. Purpose of report**
To propose the allocation of 4 grants to PFCC Community Award winners to support the work of their community safety organisations.
- 2. Recommendations**
To agree to award these one-off grants to support the work of local community safety projects.

Each and everyday people across Essex go out of their way to make a positive contribution to their communities. Whether that is through supporting vulnerable people, helping to prevent crime or making our communities safe there are a lot of individuals going above and beyond to keep their communities safe. These awards help the PFCC recognise those individuals by celebrating the contribution they make and supporting them in making a difference
- 4. Background and proposal**
This is an annual competition managed by the PFCC that seeks to identify, celebrate and promote the positive work being undertaken by local community organisations to keep Essex communities safe.


The winners are selected via a panel of independent representatives, with the exception of the People's Choice award which was subject to an online public vote.

- 5. Police and Crime Plan**
This will contribute directly to helping to reduce crime and recognise initiatives already in place. This is a key deliverable under Priority 1 of the Police and Crime Plan.
- 6. Police Operational Implications**
The event will be hosted by the OPFCC and will invite partners from across Essex including police.
- 7. Financial Implications**
The PFCC will allocate £1,200 from the 2018-19 Community Safety Fund to the organisations that the winners represent. The overall winner will receive £500 to go towards their work in the community and two highly commended winners will receive £300 each. The People's Choice Award winner will receive £100.
- 8. Legal Implications**
