1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of up to £5,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2018-19 Community Safety Fund to meet the costs of producing and launching the Essex Police Crime Prevention Strategy

2. Recommendations

2.1. Approve payment of up to £5,000 to produce and launch the overarching Crime Prevention strategy for Essex Police.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The strategy focusses on working in partnership to prevent crime and ASB in Essex. The launch event will help to cement that partnership and will lay the foundation for effective delivery.
- 3.2. A small variety of promotional/publicity materials will help to raise awareness of the steps that can be taken to prevent crime and deter potential perpetrators.
- 3.3. The launch will complement and add value to the Essex Police darker nights campaign, using traditional media and social media to raise awareness of the risk factors of crime and the preventative measures that can be taken.

4. Background and proposal

4.1. The Essex Police Crime Prevention Strategy has been redeveloped, and acts as an over-arching strategy for 9 themes of crime (Domestic abuse; Gang criminality and knife crime; Night time economy; Sexual crime, child abuse and

- exploitation; Digital crime and fraud; Extremism and radicalisation; House burglary and street robbery; Hate crime; Serious and organised crime).
- 4.2. The strategy sets out the strategic aims for each theme.
- 4.3. The strategy will be launched on 12th November at The Essex Barn, Channels. Invitees will include all local authority leaders and chief executives, CSP managers and chairs, other emergency services and a range of voluntary sector partners who will support delivery of the strategy.
- 4.4. The launch will be accompanied by media promotion to make public more aware of the risks and preventative measures, and will be followed by partnership working to ensure partners are supporting delivery where appropriate.
