1. Purpose of report

To seek approval for the allocation of £8,250 from the 2018-19 Community Safety Fund to Gangsline

2. Recommendations

Approve the allocation of £8,250 from the PFCC's 2018-19 CSF to Gangsline to continue to mentor identified young people at risk of Gang activity in Essex.

3. Benefits of Proposal

Gangsline over the term of the 2 year contract have

- Trained over 10,000 school children on the dangers of gang activity
- Held over 60 gang awareness workshops to professionals across Essex
- Mentored over 30 young people who are at risk or involved in gang activity

By providing additional funding it will ensure that at the end of the contract those individuals that still require help will continue to be supported and be given skills to divert from gang activity.

4. Background and proposal

Gangsline were appointed on a two year contract on 2nd January 2017 and provide help and support to young people involved in gang culture.

Gangsline provide training on gang culture and activity to educational establishments and professionals in 6 districts across Essex. Gangsline also provide mentoring services to young people who are at risk of or involved in gang activity.

The Gangsline contract is due to expire on 2nd January 2019. It has been identified that there are 3 young people who will continue to need support post contract expiry. To ensure these young people receive the continued support funding is sought to ensure Gangsline can provide mentoring services for a further 5 weeks at a cost of £8250
