1. Purpose of report

Updates have been required to the Information Sharing Agreements (ISAs) between:

- The PFCC and the Chief Constable for Essex Police; and
- The PFCC and the Police Fire and Crime Panel

These documents will also form schedules within the PFCC Constitution.

These ISAs have been shared with the relevant officers at both Essex Police and the Police Fire and Crime Panel and have been signed off by both parties.

They have been reviewed by the OPFCC CEO and Monitoring Officer, and legal comment from Sharpe Pritchard, along with the Information Officer and Head of Analysis at Essex Police.

It is recommended that the PFCC signs off and adopts these updated ISAs.

The updated ISAs reflect the additional requirements as a result of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data protection Act 2018.

ISAs exist between these parties in their own right and as part of the existing Constitution. These updated ISAs will ensure our compliance with relevant legislation and adoption by the current Chief Constable, PFCP and PFCC.
