### 1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £9,350 in the form of crime and disorder reduction grant to Essex Community Foundation (ECF) who will match our contribution and allocate the funding to The Essex Council for Voluntary Youth Services (ECVYS) to deliver a young people engagement project.

### 2. Recommendations

- 2.1. Approve the allocation of £9,350 to ECVYS (via ECF) as a 50% contribution for a young people engagement project.

### 3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. This project will give young people in voluntary youth organisations the chance to engage and be heard in issues and policies that affect both themselves and their communities.
- 3.2. ECVYS will design a youth session plan around 5 key questions for member groups to actively engage their young people in. ECVYS will then compile the results of the engagement and present back to the organisation and groups that took part.
- 3.3. This project will enable statutory partners to directly engage young people, and give them the opportunity to be represented and have a voice on key issues that impact them.

### 4. Background and proposal

- 4.1. The #iwill campaign is a national campaign that promotes social action among 10-20 year-olds. This includes activities such as campaigning, fundraising and

volunteering, all of which create a double-benefit – to communities and young people themselves.

- 4.2. This project benefits from 50% match-funding from the Essex Community Foundation

**5. Police and Crime Plan**

- 5.1. This funding supports the Police and Crime plan priority to crack down on anti-social behaviour and to improve local, visible and accessible policing.

**6. Police Operational Implications**

- 6.1. There is no direct operational impact on Essex Police as a result of this bid but there is an expectation that the results of the project can be used to improve the police response to engagement with young people.

**7. Financial Implications**

- 7.1. The PFCC will allocate a one-off grant of £9,350 to Essex Community Foundation which will fund ECVYS to deliver the project. The funding will be allocated from the PFCC's 2018-19 Community Safety Fund.
