1. Purpose of report

The purpose of the report is to approve the PFCC contribution to the Emergency Services Carol Service which took place in December 2018.

2. Recommendations

It is recommended that the PFCC approve £300 expenditure to support the delivery of the Emergency Services Carol Service.

3. Benefits of Proposal

The proposal will support the delivery of a collaborative blue light event for members of the emergency services across Essex, at a time when the PFCC is the governance structure for two of the three services involved.

4. Background and proposal

For the first time a joint Emergency Services Carol Concert has been held in Essex which involves Essex Police, Essex County Fire and Rescue Service and East of England Ambulance Service.

All services has participated in the planning and production of the concert. It is proposed that the Office of Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner meet the costs for the hire of the Chelmsford Cathedral, where the service was held.
