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1. Purpose of the report

To approve the allocation of £7,000 funding from the Community Safety Fund to support the development of the National Police Memorial Arboretum.

2. Recommendations

It is recommended that the PFCC provide £7,000 from the Community Safety Fund to support the development of the National Police Memorial in Staffordshire.

3. Benefits of the proposal

The project is very close to being reaching their target of £4m to build the memorial, by providing this funding this PFCC will complete the Essex target of providing £20,000 to support the development of a fitting tribute to fallen officers across the country.

4. Background and proposal

The National Memorial Arboretum in Staffordshire is the nation's place of remembrance, with 300,000 visitors a year and over 300 memorials to those who have given their lives in service to their country – but as yet there is no tribute to the Police. The Memorial will be a place where people can go to honour the service

and sacrifices made. It will also be a place where family, friends, and colleagues can go to carry out personal remembrance and reflection, supported by innovative digital commemoration, an educational programme, and support for families when they lose a loved one.

The total cost of the project is estimated to cost £4m with funding raised through central government, businesses and the public. All police forces were requested to donate £20,000 to help complete the memorial.

Essex Police and the Essex Police Federation have both agreed to contribute £7,000 each to the memorial. A £7,000 contribution from the PFCC for Essex would fulfil the Essex pledge.

5. Alternative options considered and rejected

Alternative option would be to not provide the funding, however this idea is rejected the PFCC is supportive of the memorial plans and is keen to support the initiative.

6. Police and Crime Plan

This proposal supports the wider aims of the Police and Crime Plan through supporting police officers and recognising their sacrifices.
