1. Purpose of report

- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £8,000 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to the road safety charity Brake, whose activities will contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1. To provide a grant of £8,000 from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to Brake.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. Brake is a national charity that runs the National Road Victim Service (NRVS). Brake provides specialist support for bereaved and seriously injured road crime victims in partnership with police. Victim support packs are given to bereaved families by police promptly following every road death, in line with police protocols. Brake provides advice on criminal justice procedures, practical matters, and emotional support and comfort.
- 3.2. The national helpline uses trained professionals to provide needs-orientated support, signposting, information and advocacy on emotional, practical, domestic and procedural matters, often supporting victims through criminal justice procedures, and liaising with police and other officials on families' behalf.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1. Brake's support packs and helpline are part-funded by the Ministry of Justice and other PCC offices across the country.

- 5. Alternative options considered and rejected**
 - 5.1. The PFCC has the option not to allocate this grant which would mean we would not receive a bespoke report for our area. It would also risk having a negative impact on the ability of Brake to deliver the NRVS.
- 6. Police and Crime Plan**
 - 6.1. The NRVS provides support to victims, and also reduces the harm caused by road crime.
