1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the further allocation of £114,413.50 from the Essex Police Lost and Found monies account to the Essex Community Foundation administered Police Property Act Fund.

2. Recommendations

2.1 Approve the allocation of £114,413.50 to the Essex Community Foundation managed Police Property Act Fund.

3. Benefits of Proposal

3.1 The funding is allocated to the Essex Community Foundation Police Property Act Fund. This fund aims to support community safety-related charity activities across Essex, Southend and Thurrock.

4. Background and proposal

4.1. Previously the Essex Police Authority agreed to use the surplus from the lost and found items and unclaimed monies to leave a legacy for their work and established the Police Property Act Fund with the Essex Community Foundation. The PCC has continued with this policy. This funding relates to lost and found monies from the years 1998-2007.

- 4.2. The PCC approves projects to be funded by the Police Property Act Fund, ensuring initiatives are relevant and will have a positive impact on the Police and Crime Plan.
- 4.3. This contribution is in addition to the £75,627 allocated earlier this year (decision 0046/17) which related to lost and found monies from 2013-2016.
- 5. Police and Crime Plan
- 5.1 This proposal supports the priorities in the Police and Crime Plan
- 6. Police Operational Implications
- 6.1 There are no operational implications.
- 7. Financial Implications
- 7.1 The OPCC will fund a £114,413.50 contribution to the Police Property Act Fund managed by the Essex Community Foundation. The sum of £114,413.50 is to be funded from the lost and found monies. The sum is broken down by the following outstanding balances:

The reason that these monies still being held is the fact that Essex Police were trying to ascertain the owner of the money and to ensure that they were not subject to a court order. Essex Police has had now confirmation that the monies can be transferred to ECF.
