1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £400 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to Anglia Ruskin University as a contribution to the "Tackling online child sexual exploitation" conference on 25-26 April.

2.1. To provide a grant of £400 from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to Anglia Ruskin University.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The Policing Institute of the Eastern Region (PIER) at Anglia Ruskin University is hosting its second national conference around Child Sexual Abuse (CSA). This event will take place on 25-26th April at ARU's campus in Chelmsford
- 3.2. The PIER anticipates an attendance of around 150 professionals mostly police officers and staff from around the UK. Leading speakers from academia, the voluntary sector and policing, including a major input from the NCA, will ensure an excellent programme. - 3.3. To support an evening breakout session on Thursday evening (25 April) the PFCC's contribution will provide light refreshments for delegates.
