- 1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £800 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the Community Safety Fund to Essex Police Women's Leadership Development Forum to contribute to the development and delivery of a health and wellbeing event for Essex police officers and staff.

## 3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1 Essex Police Women's Leadership Development Forum (WLDF) is planning a health and wellbeing event to take place on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2017. The event is focused on improving health and wellbeing of officer and staff across Essex Police, with invites to partner organisations.
- 3.2 The event will focus on a number of important areas in relation to improving health and wellbeing, all of which have specialist guest speakers. This event will support Essex Police officers & staff to identify ways in which they can translate wellness insights into their daily lives both within and outside of the workplace.
- 3.3 WLDF and HR partnership services are jointly launching this event to focus on staff and officer's health and wellbeing and it will involve a range of activities including health and wellbeing checks, mindfulness sessions, food stalls and support networks.
