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## 1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,500 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to pay for 5,000 branded card defenders for distribution by members of the Business Crime Strategic Board to staff and stakeholders. The activities of the board contribute to the priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan for Essex.

#### 2. Recommendations

2.1. To provide a grant of £1,500 from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to pay for the design, production and delivery of 5,000 units.

### 3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. The Business Crime Strategic Board consists of representatives from the PFCC's office, Essex Chambers of Commerce, Essex Police, and business representatives from large and small businesses across the county. Its aim is to work together to reduce business crime and make Essex a safer and more prosperous place to do business.
- 3.2. The Board has recently agreed a communications strategy to raise awareness of the Board and to spread crime prevention messages. These card defenders are recognised as a good crime prevention product in the fight against card cloning and are good promotional opportunities to share messaging.
- 3.3. The PFCC would like to fund the first tranche of this PR activity to raise awareness and encourage other businesses to take part and get involved.

## 4. Background and proposal

4.1. The card defenders are produced by approved Essex Police supplier Solon Security which has supplied the product for previous events such as the launch of the Essex Police Crime Prevention Strategy.

## 5. Alternative options considered and rejected

5.1. The PFCC has the option not to allocate this money but that could affect the relationship with stakeholders and be perceived as demonstrating a lack of commitment to the work of the Board by the PFCC.

#### 6. Police and Crime Plan

6.1. The Business Crime Strategic Board supports the delivery of the Police and Crime Plan, contributing directly to our Vision for Essex that Safe and secure communities are the bedrock on which we build success and wellbeing for all.

## 7. Police Operational Implications

7.1. Providing businesses and residents with a crime prevention product that helps to reduce card fraud will help to prevent crimes from happening in the first place, reducing the impact on operational policing.

## 8. Financial Implications

8.1. OPFCC will fund a one off contribution of £1,500 from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to Solon Security to fund the card defenders.
