1. Purpose of report

1.1. To seek approval for the allocation of £1,500 in the form of a crime and disorder reduction grant from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund to Essex Police as a contribution to the 2020 International Women's Day Conference.

2.1. To provide a grant of £1,500 from the 2019-20 Community Safety Fund as a contribution to the 2020 International Women's Day Conference.

3. Benefits of Proposal

- 3.1. International Women's Day is a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. The day also marks a call to action for accelerating gender parity. The conference supports the diversity, inclusion and cultural priorities of all three emergency services.
- 3.2. The conference will be held at Hylands House and will bring together 300 attendees from Essex Police, Essex County Fire & Rescue Service and East of England Ambulance Service.

4. Background and proposal

- 4.1. This is an annual event that seeks to empower women and highlight opportunities for equality and gender parity.
- 4.2. This event is jointly funded equally between the Women's Leadership Development Forum, Essex Police, East of England Ambulance Service and Essex County Fire & Rescue Service.

- 5.1. The PFCC has the option not to allocate this funding, but our contribution will help to raise awareness and support women within emergency services.
- 5.2. The PFCC has previously supported this conference in 2018 & 2019.
