REPORT PURPOSE

The board is asked to note and agree the proposals to replace the current ECFRS CRM data solution with an alternative solution as outlined in the attached draft Project Initiation Document (PID).

BACKGROUND

The Data Management Programme board, chaired by the Director of Operations, met on 30 January 2020. A key decision was to agree on the future of the current CRM solution.

The Board agreed that CRM be replaced and an aggressive timescale set to achieve the implementation of a new solution to support Technical fire safety and Community fire safety activities. To this end, a CRM exit strategy has been developed whilst the attached formal PID outlines steps for a new system to be in place by June 2020.

BENEFITS AND RISK IMPLICATION

The introduction of a new system will mitigate existing organisational risk which is captured in ECFRS JCAD risk management system: SRR000015.

Risks specifically associated with this project are captured in JCAD and are replicated at section 5.3 (p.14) of the PID.
