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1. Purpose of the report

To approve the allocation of from the PFCC's communications budget for the annual subscription for Granicus Electronic Newsletter Service (EGOV Bulletins).

2. Recommendations

Approve the allocation of from the PFCC's communication budget to continue with this service.

3. Benefits of the proposal

The Granicus platform supports the delivery of the PFCC's weekly newsletter, regular bulletins and useful news to subscribers across Essex. It supports the PFCC in engaging with the public.

The reach of the service has grown significantly since it was introduced in 2019 and it is anticipated that this growth will continue for the foreseeable future. The system currently has 7,518 subscribers – a growth of 92 per cent over the past 12 months. In the past year 63 bulletins have been issued. Each bulletin has an average engagement rate of 75 per cent.

Providing this regular information has help build awareness of the role of the PFCC, build confidence in the police and fire and rescue services and enables residents and businesses to access clear and easy to understand information about the work of the PFCC, Essex Police, Essex County Fire and Rescue Services

4. Background and proposal

The Granicus EGOV system is the most popular public sector direct electronic mail delivery service both in the UK and worldwide. It provides a quick and efficient way to reach large sections of the community. One of the benefits for subscribers is the ability to tailor which content they would to see and be introduced to similar topics which they may find of interest.

Because so many public sector organisations use the service in Essex, as well as other government organisations across the UK, we receive a significant number of new subscribers from people who have already registered with these other organisations. In this way we can build an audience base that is outside of our normal channels.

The service is also fully compliant with our obligations under GDPR and benefits from continuous development.

5. Alternative options considered and rejected

We could stop our subscription to this service, but we would then reach less people across Essex. This would limit their ability to understand the work the PFCC does, leading to a probable reduction in their confidence in the services we have responsibility for.

6. Police and Crime Plan

This service helps sections of our community engage with the police and crime plan and the work of the commissioner.
