Station culture

The Station culture around availability has changed, how we continue to crew the second appliance due to leave and sickness has become very challenging. I have discussed the need of the station management team to pick this up on a 1-1 basis. The low level of activity has reduced morale on station. We have been trying to encourage individuals into station for activities but have not had a good take up due to individual time limitations.
