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Executive Summary

The **Transforming Public Procurement programme** aims to improve the way public procurement is regulated in order to:

- Create a simpler and more flexible, commercial system that better meets our country's needs while remaining compliant with our international obligations;
- Open up public procurement to new entrants such as small businesses and social enterprises so that they can compete for and win more public contracts;
- Embed transparency throughout the commercial lifecycle so that the spending of taxpayers' money can be properly scrutinised.

The Procurement Bill, which will reform the existing Procurement Rules, is now going through Parliament.

The team are ensuring that we keep up to date with all the developments and upcoming changes on how public procurement will change to improve the way supplies, services and works are procured for the public sector. We will receive 6 months notice of 'Go Live' which is expected to be early 2024 but we need to start getting prepared now.

- Recruitment for the Property and FM Category Manager is ongoing.
- The team are working with ICT and stakeholders to evaluate and redesign our New Vendor Form.
- There were two STA's in January.

- **Devices replacement project –** Budget of £250,000 to be used to source via tendering on CCS RM6068 Lot 1. Final figures for specification being decided.
- Pagers and notifications contract Contract stage with PageOne via framework RM3808 Lot 7 from the CCS.
- Renewal of Water Management System Fire Hydrant location and identification. Sourcing via a request for quotation with 3 current suppliers.



Corporate Services and Operations Category Headlines

Work progressing on the following projects:

- New Fleet Appliances budget £4m over 2 years tender is now closed and under evaluation 3 submissions received.
- **Treadmills** budgeted at £254k for 6 years tender live closes 20th February as a further competition under the ESPO framework.
- **External Auditor** estimated £225k for 5 year contract tender live, due to close 3rd February. 7 Forces are leading on this procurement.
- Legal services estimated £70K PA, in final tender preparation to run under a framework with 7 Forces leading.
- **Purchasing Cards** estimated £215k spend per year, with third parties but rebate approx. £500 per year, no charges for cards, under evaluation under CCS framework Payment Solutions 2.
- **Provision of heavy plant and operator for waste fires** tender closed in January for the supply of a specialist advisor and heavy plant for waste fires and fires within industrial/agricultural buildings, evaluation underway.
- **Undress** following approval to move to an inhouse managed service provision plans have begun to put this in place and the Service will provide all Operational staff at Station Manager and above with tailored undress.
- **Boarding Up** another supplier added for resilience to ensure that we have two providers who can assist 24/7 across the county.
- Hybrid vehicles Decision Sheet submitted for the purchase of 20 hybrid vehicles.
