

Procurement Dashboard May 2023



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Executive Summary

- Our Category Manager for Property starts on the 14th August.
- Introduction meeting held with Bluelight Commercial (BLC) to understand how we can work together and the service provided by BLC. Due to the upcoming changes to the NFCC Procurement Hub we await further details as to how The Hub and BLC will work together and work for the fire sector going forward.
- Review of PPE annual indexation, a Decision Sheet is prepared each year due to the changing numbers and therefore value of the contract each year.
- There were no STA's in May.



Property / FM Category Headlines

Work progressing on the following projects:

- **PPM Electrical** Evaluation continues focussing on the commercial responses to ensure an accurate assessment of costs.
- Cleaning NFCC collaborative tender with 3 other Fire and Rescue Services tender closed at the beginning of May with 5 responses received for Essex, evaluation of tender responses are taking place.
- **Asbestos** –(re-inspections and re-assessments of the condition of asbestos containing materials identified in our buildings to ensure compliance with legislation) approx. spend £25k for the initial term, 3 year contract with 2 x 12 month extensions available, joint procurement run by 7 Forces went live on the 12th May.
- BA Chambers (Harlow and Saffron Walden) estimated cost £475,000 to £550,000 preparing tender documents for the retender of this project.
- Orsett Fire Station Fire Risk Assessment & Whole Time Fire Station Refurbishment expected cost £600k extension to deadline given of one week, tender returns now due on the 2nd June.

ICT Category Headlines

Work progressing on the following projects:

- Financial Software replacement waiting for PFCC sign off.
- **Fire station Network resilience data sims –** Budget of £10,000 per year, two contracts to be awarded as a direct award under CCS RM6261 Lot 1. This is to replace possible network risk Telefonica SIMS.
- **Solarwinds renewal –** Renewal of our network monitoring solution via a request for quotation. Contract awarded for one year at £10,000.
- Market engagement for BaaS Expected budget of £50,000 p/a for Backup as a Service solution for added resilience for Microsoft 365 planner. Engagement of clarifications from offerings on CCS G-Cloud 13 framework. G-Cloud offerings unsuitable and now looking at a Request for Quote process with demonstrations starting in June.
- **Email Delivery Platform** 3 year contract term at £17,000 for the replacement and implementation of the current existing solution to assist the communications team. This was sourced and now awarded via G-Cloud 13. Implementation to begin in June. Additional cost from existing contract of £3,500 due to additional demand.
- Renewal of Storage Area Network (SAN) support Requirement of Hewlett Packard Enterprises (HPE) SAN support and maintenance. A request for quotation was completed with 3 providers for 3rd party support, awarded to incumbent supplier due to short term renewal required ready for the new control system at £21,000.



Corporate Services and Operations Category Headlines

Work progressing on the following projects:

- **New Fleet Appliances -** budget £4m over 2 years awarded, contract with Commissioner for signature.
- **Treadmills** budgeted at £181k for 6 years awarded and standstill complete. Contract ready for signature.
- Workwear tender preparation underway, pre-engagement with suppliers took place early May. Amendments to
 the call off contract terms under the YPO Framework agreed for inclusion in tender. Further options are being
 considered as part of our Protecting our People project.
- Heavy plant and operator provision tender closed and one response received, a decision sheet will be submitted for approval to proceed to tender award.
- Community Risk Management Plan (CRMP) £38,500 contract signed, for creation of a baseline report, location optimisation report, Scenario evaluation report, additional pumping appliance modelling and optimal distribution of specialist appliances.
- Public Perception survey Request for quote preparation underway.
- Heatwave requirements Purchased: water bottles, water coolers, ice makers, backpack sprayers, fog spikes.
 Interim purchases complete for hoses (further tender to be run for larger requirements). Request for quote uderwy for thermal imaging cameras.
- Tyres working with Fleet on the procurement of tyres under the CCS framework.



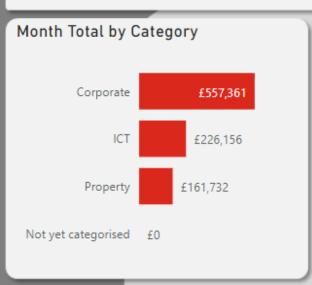

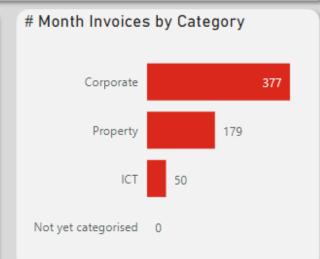

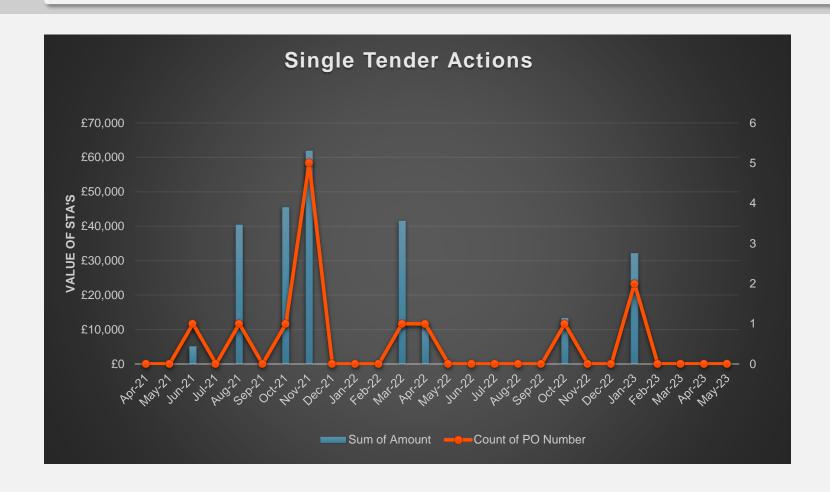
Contract for MFC sheeting has run past its expiry date, this is due to the workload within the team and other tenders that have had to take priority and therefore delayed this tender being sent out.

When this contract was previously tendered only one company responded, it is not a specialist product but is critical for training, it was therefore deemed an acceptable risk to allow this supplier to continue to be used and a tender run over the next couple of months for the long term supply needs. The contract value is below the Find a Tender threshold advertising requirements but as per our financial regulations it will be advertised on contracts finder, there are no suitable frameworks for this product.
